KEYNOTE SPEAKER



Josef Kittler University of Surrey, UK

Josef Kittler (Life Member, IEEE) received the BA, PhD, and DSc degrees from the University of Cambridge, in 1971, 1974, and 1991, respectively. He is currently a distinguished professor of machine intelligence with the Centre for Vision, Speech and Signal Processing, University of Surrey, Guildford, U.K. He has published the textbook Pattern Recognition: A Statistical Approach and about 1000 scientific articles. His publications have been cited by around 70,000 times. His research interests include biometrics, video and image database retrieval, medical image analysis, and cognitive vision. He also served as a member of the editorial board for the IEEE Transactions on Pattern Analysis and Machine Intelligence from 1982 to 1985. He served on the Governing Board for the International Association for Pattern Recognition (IAPR) as one of the two British representatives from 1982 to 2005 and the president of IAPR from 1994 to 1996. He is a series editor of Lecture Notes in Computer Science (Springer).

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
